**15 MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 13<sup>TH</sup> MAY 2014.**

**16 REPORTS:**

**Crime report:** 9/5/2014 to 9/6/2014: Between 7/5/2014 and 13/5/2014: 500 litres of heating oil was stolen from the tank located at the rear of the village hall. A padlock was forced and removed to facilitate this offence. All usual lines of enquiry have been pursued with nothing gleaned to benefit either investigation. Undoubtedly this crime is linked to.....During the late evening of 13/5/2014 (the evening of the Annual Parish Meeting), a pedal cycle was left insecure and unattended at the rear of the village hall. On the owner returning for it later that evening, it was found to be missing. A local area search for the bike was made the following day but to date, it's yet to be found. Officer dealing for both matters is Pc 270 Marshall.
