112: MATTERS ARISING:

Walcher's meadow:

Quotation: for new (larger) gate, removal of gate, necessary hedge and fixing £480.00 (inc VAT).

Approx. cost for *new posts when new gate is in place. £72.00 (inc VAT).

Note: Possibility of some financial help from Cllr. Kemp's Locality Budget?

Quotation: £1244.00 for work to be carried out dismantling and accessing 8 timber posts (climbing frame).

Fixing new galvanised steel ground anchors. Re-erecting climbing frame and securing into the ground with post-crete. The Councillors discussed these quotations and approved them. This was proposed by Cllr. A. Irish, seconded by Cllr. D.C. Griggs, all in favour.

Quotation for a "Kiss Gate": To be erected near *new gate for the children's safety.

Quotations to be obtained for the above. To be included on the agenda for May.

Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) (Parish Infrastructure Investment Policy (PIIP): This was discussed and the Councillors requested the Clerk include this in the Round & About magazine to suggest a future a Public Meeting for residents to attend, to be held as a Public Consultation to complete a Parish Infrastructure Investment Plan for the future.
