A meeting was held on the 17<sup>th</sup> June to discuss the possibility of going ahead with this project. The members were given information for them to peruse. Another meeting is to be arranged in the near future.

**S106 Funds update:** This will be included on the agenda for September for further discussion.

**Parking at School:** Cllr. Kemp is in contact with S.C.C. regarding this matter.

**Bus shelter at Churchill Close:** Cllr. Kemp is in contact with S.C.C. regarding the extension of the waiting area.

**Lawnmower:** The possibility of purchasing a replacement mower for the P.C. was discussed as the old lawnmower is no longer viable. The Clerk will research some prices for a second hand mower. This will be included on the agenda for August. Cllr. Kemp informed the P.C. that Locality Budget funds are available.

**27 FINANCE:**

**Lawshall Youth Club:** Re: paying 50% rent for the village hall. This was discussed and it was decided that the P.C. would continue paying 50% of the rent charge until the end of the financial year (31 March 2015). This was proposed by Cllr. J. Kydd, seconded by Cllr. D.C. Griggs, all in favour.
