17 MATTERS ARISING:

S106: Cllr. J. Kydd reported that he had received an offer to cut the area in the middle of Walchers Meadow for a recreation area. Quote was for £40.00. This was discussed and it was decided to accept this offer, this was proposed by Cllr. J. Kydd and seconded by Cllr. D.C. Griggs, all in favour.

Ride-on mower: An idea was put forward to possibly purchase a ride-on mower. Also to check with BDC if this is eligible for S106 funds. If this purchase did go ahead it would need to be stored in a secure place. A suggestion was made for the Clerk to ask the Village Hall Management Committee if the P.C. could have a small shed on village hall land.

Speed Watch Scheme: An offer to help with training for this project has been received from Hawstead P.C. This project will be included in the July magazine and ask for any volunteers.

Neighbourhood Plan: To date two offers of help have been received by the Clerk. This project will be included in the July magazine asking for any volunteers.
