42 MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING HELD ON 12th AUGUST, 2014

43 REPORTS:

Crime report: from 4th August to 26th August 2014: Assault/Public Order: causing an affray in a street in Lawshall, offender was arrested and cautioned for this offence.

Cllr. R. Kemp report: This has been circulated to Councillors.

Dcllr. J. Long report: no report for this month.

44 MATTERS ARISING:

S106 Funds: A brief discussion took place. This will be resumed for further discussion when all the business is completed.

Babergh D.C. Invitation to attend S106 meeting on the 10th September at BDC. None of the Councillors were able to attend this meeting due to work commitments, so Mr Graham Cooper (who had collated all the information re: S106 surveys) offered to attend and will report to the Council.

S.C.C. acknowledgement received: re: report of the state of the road in Hartest Lane – these repairs should take place shortly. The Clerk had also enquired if S.C.C. was prepared to cut back the trees in Lawshall Row. Reply was that this is not the responsibility of S.C.C.

Bradnams Tree Services: quotation received for £50.00 for cutting the hedge/trees along Lawshall Row.

The Councillors discussed this quotation. Cllr. J. Kydd proposed that the P.C. accept this quotation, seconded by Cllr. D. Lindsay, all in favour. The Clerk inform Mr Bradnam that the quotation is accepted.

School re-organisation: the parking situation is under review. Further meetings are to be arranged.

Babergh D.C. acknowledgement: Re: advertising planning applications: Not all applications need to be advertised in the EADT as Site Notices are put in place on site and letters to neighbours. All applications such as Listed Buildings, Conservation Areas, Public Rights of Way, and all major applications are advertised.

Mid Suffolk D.C. Questionnaire: Community Caretaker Scheme: The Clerk will complete the questionnaire and return to Mid Suffolk D.C.
