**105: PLANNING:**

**Application No. B/16/00189: Audley End Farm, Melford Road: received after the agenda had been prepared and is a 7 day return:** Notification under Part 6 & 7 of Schedule 2 of the Town & Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 – erection of agricultural building for storage of farm machinery and crops. Cllr. J. Kydd proposed that this application is included for discussion, seconded by Cllr. D.C. Griggs, all in favour. The Councillors discussed this application and the conclusion was that the application is supported with the stipulation that the building is used solely for agricultural purposes.

**S106 FUNDS for project at Walcher’s Meadow:**

All the evidence required for the project was sent to Mr Nick Elliott (Babergh D.C.) on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2015. Confirmation was received by email dated 10<sup>th</sup> December, 2015 from Mr Elliott that the evidence produced was acceptable.

There are 2 new requirements: 3 new notice boards are required for the project also a strimmer (this is to allow the grass to be kept short in areas such as under the benches and trees, where a mower cannot reach.)

All the quotations were discussed, approved and agreed. This was proposed by Cllr. T. Elmer, seconded by Cllr. A. Irish, all in favour.

The form for the S106 funds will be completed and copies of the 2 new quotations will be sent to Mr Elliott along with a list of all the other items required for the project.
